### **AAT licensing**

- Licensing scheme available to AAT Bookkeepers, Full and Fellow members
- Apply to be a Licensed Accountant or Licensed Bookkeeper
- Full and Fellow members can apply to be a Licensed Accountant
- AAT Bookkeepers, Full members & Fellow members can apply to be a Licensed Bookkeeper
- Licensed Accountants can apply to be licensed in 18 services
- Licensed Bookkeepers can apply to be licensed in 4 services (tier 4 only)
- Criteria for licensing and application at aat.org.uk/licence

## What work can I do as a licensed member?

#### Tier 1

- Company secretarial services
- Independent examination
- Limited assurance engagement
- Forensic accounting
- Internal Audit

#### Tier 2

- Personal income tax
- Business income tax
- Corporation tax
- Capital gains tax
- Inheritance tax

#### Tier 3

- Budgeting and forecasting
- Management accounting
- Payroll
- Financial accounting and Accounts preparation for statutory purposes

#### Tier 4

- Bookkeeping
- Financial accounting and Accounts preparation for sole traders & partnerships
- Value added tax
- Computerised accountancy systems

### What CPD do I need to do?

- Need to provide details of CPD undertaken in services wish to offer
- Compliance with CPD policy mandatory CPD cycle Assess, Plan, Action, Evaluate
- Assess CPD needs in every service approved to offer and in practice management
- CPD consists of activities which result in learning and keeping skills up to date

What order should I do things – get clients or apply for licence first?

You must have the following in place before you start to offer services to clients:

- Your AAT licence
- Professional Indemnity Insurance
- Anti-money laundering supervision
- Registration with Information Commissioner

### How do I know what to charge clients?

- Different pricing options fee per job, annual fee, standing order
- Knowing your local market & competitors
- Don't undersell yourself

# Can you tell me about the legal requirements of setting up a practice?

- Have a supervisory authority for compliance with the Money Laundering Regulations 2007
- Register with the Information Commissioner for compliance with the Data Protection Act
- Register with HMRC
- Arrange payment of Class 2 NI
- Register for VAT?

I understand I need someone to provide continuity for my practice, what does this mean & who can it be?

- Someone to take on your client work if you are unable to work for some time
- Your nominated person must have sufficient experience and expertise
- A partner, director or suitably qualified employee could provide this
